## Foreword

In the Southwest region of Bangladesh, the indigenous “Munda” people have been living as an isolated community for the last 200 years. Since 1997, Coastal Development partnership (CDP) has been working with the “Munda” people to promote their identity and ensure their rights. It is a pleasure for us that we have successfully completed the project “*Ensuring Democratic Rights of the Munda Community of Southwest region of Bangladesh through proper enrollment in ongoing voter list*” with the support of The Asia Foundation.

The project activities have sensitized the concerned authorities of the 5 Unions of the Magura District and 10 Unions of the Jhinaidah District about the Munda community. The project has facilitated 899 Munda people for being enrolled as voters. The involvement of the Munda people as project staff to carry out activities with the Munda community has created stronger solidarity for democratic rights among them. The project has created a good self-image among the community people (Munda).

More than five hundred (500) people from Munda community were present in the community awareness meetings of the project. The Munda Community of Southwest region of Bangladesh has at least earned scope to participate in the national democratic process through this project. Although the project was mainly focused on ensuring Munda people in the voter list, Munda community have expressed their concern for future and also provided some strategic directions. We believe that in future we should carry on our work following those directions.

At the end, we would like to express our gratitude to Munda Communities, The Asia Foundation, staff members of the CDP, government officials, UP chairman & members, Information Collectors for providing us guidance, advice and suggestions for the better implementation and effectiveness of the project. We would like thank all the people whom the project team meets during the implementation.

## 1.1 Background of the Project

Although more than thousands of indigenous Munda people have been living in the south-west Bangladesh for the last two hundred years, they are neither properly recognized by Government Officials nor by the mainstream indigenous leaders/organizations. They are not incorporated in national development agendas. Indigenous Munda community is ignored by all and may be termed as 'Forgotten Community'. Detachment from both the mainstream society as well as from the development process has made the Munda community as forgotten ethnic entity. No appropriate and adequate measures have been taken for the empowerment and betterment of life style of the indigenous Munda people. In the democratic process, they are still outsider, in LEB, their representatives are virtually absent. It has to be noted that CDP is one of the pioneer NGO in terms of working with the indigenous "Munda" people to promote their identity and raise their unheard voices to the Policy makers as well as in the national development agendas' since it's inception in 1997. Considering the above context, the Coastal Development Partnership (CDP) with the support of The Asia Foundation made effort for the proper enrollment Munda people in the present voter listing process.

### **Coastal Development Partnership On Democratic Awareness And Election Monitoring**

With the cooperation of Uttaran, Coastal development Partnership organized some awareness campaign under Civic Awareness Program during the 9<sup>th</sup> National Election. Most of the activities have been performed in Khulna Constituency#5 (Dumuria and Phultal) and Bagerhat Constituency# 4 (Sharankhola and Morelgonj). Major activities were Formation of Community Level Election Campaign Cell, Formation of civil society Election brigade, Community Level Sensitization meeting with Religion-Ethnic Minorities, Community Sensitization meeting with Disable people, Community level Sensitization meeting with Old voters, Community Level Sensitization and information Dissemination meeting, and Round Table with Regional News Papers. In addition, CDP conducted Election observance and voter Education in Bagerhat Constituency#4 (Sharankhola and Morelgonj). Under Election Monitoring and Civic Voter Education Program with the cooperation of Democracy Watch, CDP organized awareness campaign during the 9<sup>th</sup> National Election. Most of the activities (selection of observers for pre and post election monitoring, capacity building of the Upazilla level coordinators) have been performed in Khulna Constituency#5 (Dumuria and Phultala). Under Election Monitoring and Governance Project with the cooperation of BROTEE, CDP organized capacity building training and conducted survey in 5 Unions on Voter list in Fakirhat upazilla of Bagerhat district. CDP established a regional network on Munda community. Under this network the Mundas of Magura, and Jenidah are incorporated. Their issues are raised in a coordinated way through this network.

## 1.2 Description of the Project

On April 9, 2008 Coastal Development Partnership (CDP) has signed an agreement with The Asia Foundation to implement the project named as "Ensuring Democratic Rights of the Munda Community of southwest region of Bangladesh through proper enrollment in ongoing voter list." After signing the agreement on April 9, 2008 the organization has taken initiatives to implement the project in the project area among the target beneficiary groups/community from 9<sup>th</sup> April, 2008 to 10<sup>th</sup> July 2008 through involving skilled and experienced staff members.

The goal of the project was to ensure proper enrollment of indigenous people (Munda) in voter list so that the Munda community will be recognized as indigenous and active citizen of Bangladesh and they will be incorporated in national development agendas.

To achieve this goal, CDP was focused on the following three objectives:

1. To create awareness among Munda communities.
2. To ensure proper enrollment in voter list.
3. To recognize their identity through incorporate them into democratic process.

### 1.3 Beneficiaries of the Project/ the Indigenous Munda community

The beneficiary of this project is the Indigenous community “Munda”, one of the most disadvantaged segments of populations in 15 unions of Magura and Jhenaidah districts.

Munda (locally known as Buno/ Bunia) is one of twenty (20) indigenous communities are living in Jhinaidah, Magura, Jessore, Satkhira and Bagerhat districts in the south western region of Bangladesh. The Munda community is one of the most deprived and discriminated communities in Bangladesh and living with chronic poverty. Two hundred years ago, Mundas were brought to former East Bengal and today's Bangladesh, from Ranchi of Jarkandh and Bakura, Nagpur, Birbhum, Purulia, Saotal Pargona and Medinipur districts of the west Bengal of India by the then landlords and/or the East India Company for cultivation in certain part of Sundarbans and also as skilled fighter with sticks. However, they are the first settlers in their present habitat. The Mundas living in Bangladesh are divided into two casts- the "Munda" cast and the "Munda Mahato" cast. They live in the south-western region, especially in the southern part of Khulna

district, Satkhira and in the area adjacent to the Sundarbans. Existing literature reveals that around 1500 to 2000 Mundas live in 15 villages of Koyra thana in Khulna district and other 3000 to 3500 Mundas live in 18 villages of Tala and Symnagar thana in Shatkhira district.

Most of the Mundas are landless. The Munda community has their own religious, language and culture. The Mundas are the followers of the 'Sanatan' (original form of Hindu) religion and mainly worships the god 'Shiva' (symbol of energy and life). Though, once the society of Mundas was mother dominated, now the families are father dominated. They have their own 'Morol' (chief of clan) and 'Raja'(king). A Morol dominates a clan and the Raja dominates a good number of clans. The Morols and the king give directives in their social and religious life. They have a special kind of dance of their own namely 'Nupur' dance. Wearing nupur (an anklet set with small bells) in ankle the Mundas dance in a chorus with music. Most of the Mundas marry within their community. The Mundas of Koyra thana in Khulna district marry with the Mundas of Shymnagar thana in Satkhira district. They marry in their teen age, just like the "Gaouri" (child hood marriage) custom of the ancient Hindus.

According to Mundas, once they were owners of the land. Bengalese have forcibly grabbed major portion of their land in possession. They are to live a life of disadvantaged and neglected community for economic depression, social alienation and denying rights to access to natural resources. Moreover powerful elements of mainstream people, Bengalese forcible dispossess them from land, hindering them to have accessibility to government owned khas land and water bodies. Bangladesh's Disaster Management Information Centre reported that two indigenous communities, the Munda and Mahato, in Sundarban area and the Rakhain community in Patuakhali were affected by the cyclone Sidr in late 2007.

## 1.4 Project Areas

The project has worked with Munda communities in 10 unions of Jhenaidah District and 5 unions of Magura District.

## 1.5 Project Activities

**01. Inception Staff Meeting:** The project inception meeting was organized at April 30, 2008 and intensive review on the action plan, budgetary control, main objectives, location, implementation strategy, monitoring, evaluation, goals, reporting and documentation of the project had been done.

**02. Monthly Review & Coordination Meeting:** Two monthly coordination meetings with the participation of the Union coordinators, Thana Coordinators and the Project coordinator were held to review the project progress and to plan for the next phase. First meeting was held at 26th may, 2008 in Shailkupa union of Shailkupa Upazilla in Jhenaidah district and the second one was took place at 19th June, 2008 in Binodpur union of Mohammadpur upazila in Magura District. The

whole day discussion reviewed the project activities of 10 unions in Jhenaidah district and 5 unions of Magura district to devise the future working plan.

**03. Union level Meeting with Communities people (Munda):** In total fifteen (15) meetings were conducted at Union level with the Munda communities. Ten (10) meetings were took place in Jhenidah district and five (5) meetings were in Magura district. Five hundred twenty three

(523) people from Munda community were present in these meetings and project staff discussed about various facilities which Munda communities are entitled to receive as citizen of Bangladesh. Participants of the meetings discussed about how the Munda community can have access to various facilities if they enroll their name in the voter list. In these meetings it is also discussed about the current miserable status of the Munda community and how their status could be better by enrolling their name in voter list.

**04. Union level Meeting with Concerned Authorities (Up Chairman, Members and Information Collectors):** In total fifteen (15) meetings were conducted at Union level with the

concerned authorities. Ten (10) meetings were took place in Jhenidah district and five (5) meetings were in Magura district. Three hundred fifty four (354) participants, among the concerned government officials (UNO, Election officer, Law and order enforcement authority), voter information collectors, the representatives of the local government (UP Chairman & UP Members), civil society members (teacher, doctor, social leaders, opinion leaders, journalists etc) were present in these meetings. The representatives of concerned authorities agreed to assist and aware the Munda community for enrolling their name in the voter list. Civil society members demanded that the concerned authorities should be more active for enrolling the Munda community in the voter list to ensure their democratic rights.

**05. Satellite information Center (SIC):** Districts level existing satellite information centers will disseminate the relevant information among the Mundas communities and others. Four information dissemination discussion meetings were organized by the satellite information center for the information collection and dissemination. CDP established two (2) Satellite information centers in Shailkupa Union in Jhenidah District and Binodpur Union in Magura District.

In every week, group discussion took place in the SIC center on various aspects of the Munda community, their socio-economic condition, their living pattern, how to disseminate information among the Munda communities to enroll their name in the voter list. These satellite information centers also collected information and documented it. In group discussion, the leaflet, Adibashi barta etc are used to be reviewed.

**06. Cultural Program on their own language and culture:** Two (2) drama shows and two (2) group songs performance by the Munda artists were organized to aware the

Munda community for enrolling their name in the voter list. Two (2) dramas were arranged at Shailkupa Union in Jhenidah District and Binodpur Union in Magura District. The cultural programs (group songs performance) arranged at Avaipur Union in Jhenidah District and Mohammadpur Union in Magura District. Munda artists composed, tuned and performed dramas and songs in their own language to aware their community members for enrolling their names in voter list.

**07. Leaflet:** The leaflets which were provided by The Asia Foundation were distributed in every Union Parishad (UP) of Jhenidah and Magura districts, various Adivashi Organizations and their community to aware them about the enrollment of their name in the voter list. These

leaflets were also distributed in villages through Satellite information Center (SIC). Various slogans like "Vote is our democratic rights so every one needs to be voter", encourage people to provide various facilities etc are focused in this leaflet. All of these are done to encourage people for enrollment their name in the list.

**08. Documentation and Reporting:** All the project activities like inception meeting, monthly review & coordination meeting, meeting with Munda communities, meeting with concerned authorities (GO officials, UP Chairman, Members, Journalist and Information Collectors), drama shows, group discussion etc are documented and preserved.

The project developed a database of the Munda community members who have already enrolled in the voter list by the project activities. The database already recorded 899 Munda who were enrolled as voters during the project period. The Munda Voter database recorded information about 563 Mundas in Shailkupa Upazilla of Jenaidah District and among them 310 are male and 253 are female voters. In Mohammadpur Upazilla of Magura District, the database has recorded 333 Munda voters and among them 310 are male and 253 are female voters. Although many Mundas who were voter after the project are not in the database due to completion of the project, it can be assumed that the actual number of Munda voter will be much higher.

## 1.6 Human Resource of the Project

In total eighteen (18) persons were involved to implement the project. More than fourth-fifth (83.3%) of the project staffs was from the Munda Community. One Project Coordinator was responsible for the overall activities of the project. Two (02) Thana Coordinators were responsible for supervising the project under the direct guidance of the Project coordinator. Fifteen (15) Union Coordinators were recruited from the Munda communities for community mobilization.

The 899 Munda people were enrolled in the voter list during the project period. Among the enrolled Mundas in the voter list, 52% are male (468) and 48% are female (428).

## 1.9 Project Impact

The people of the Munda community have received knowledge about the various facilities for citizens and also the potential benefits of enrolling their names in the voter list. The Munda become aware about their democratic rights and importance of vote for ensuring their rights. The Munda community was deprived from all types of basic need. They did not get health facilities or any types of treatment from govt. health centre. But now they know that as citizen they are entitled to claim for these facilities and also to demand education for their children.

The Munda community has been living as an isolated community for the last 200 years. The concerned authorities as well as mainstream community were not concerned about the culture, society, problems, livelihood struggles and also the children of the Munda community. However, the interaction of the Munda community through various project activities has created scope of interaction with the concerned authority like chairman, UNO and various journalists.

The project activities have sensitized the authority and the mainstream people of the 5 Unions of the Magura District and 10 Unions of the Jhinaidah District about the Munda community.

The project made success to keep the gender balance (Female: Male = 1:1.1) during the enrollment of the Mundas in the voter list. The 899 Munda people who were enlisted as voter by the project are now eligible to have access in the following facilities:

1. Getting a passport and renewal
2. Getting Driving license and renewal
3. Getting Taxpayer Identification number (TIN)
4. Getting the admit card to appear in the S.S.C, H.S.C and others examinations.
5. Apply for various Government services.
6. Obtain Business Identification Number (BIN)
7. Open bank accounts
8. Obtain loan from various banks and micro credit organizations
9. Get various Government allowances
10. Sale and buy of lands and properties
11. Get trade license
12. Sale and buy of transports
13. Participate in various insurance schemes
14. Marriage registration
15. Identify voters in various elections
16. Admission in various education institutions
17. Gas, Water and electric connections
18. Connection of telephone, Mobile Phone, Internet, Cable TV
19. To get various subsidy and aid of government.
20. To lodge /file any case, appeal and petition in court
21. To open BO account and share application

The involvement of the Munda people as project staff to carry out activities with the Munda community has created stronger solidarity for democratic rights among them. In addition, 16 Munda people who worked as project staff have gained professional experience.

One of the most significant impacts of the project is that it highlighted the existence of Munda community in Magura and Jenaidah Districts. It has to be noted that the existing literature and development efforts is only focused on Mundas in the Khulna and Satkhira Districts.

### **1.10 Limitation**

The project was mainly focused to aware Munda people about their democratic rights. However, it was not possible to directly aware Munda people about their social and economic rights.

## 1.11 Lessons learned: Small initiative can make big change

The project has shown that some small initiative can bring big and sustainable change for the whole community. The following two case studies of Munda community might provide new thoughts:

### Case study 1: **Krishna's mother-A leader for Democratic Tomorrow**

Munda parents are not interested about education of their children because of poverty. Besides, the children of Mohammadpur village in Magura District are not interested to go to school due to the prevailing discriminatory attitude within the school. The children of the mainstream people and classmates used to humiliate Munda children by saying “Buno (wild/uncivilized/animal-like)” but the teachers of the school do not take any step to protect them from such humiliation. This cycle of humiliation is going on year after year. Through project when Munda mother's came to know that it is their democratic rights to express their demands, Munda women under the leadership of Krishna's mother went to the nearby non-government primary school with their children and informed teachers about all of these problems. Teachers heard all of the problems and then take measures to ensure school. Now the Munda children of the Mohammadpur village attend school regularly.

### Case study 2: **Aspirations for Democratic Tomorrow**

Living standard of the Munda community in Abaipur village of Jhenaidah District is very stumpy. Most of the families led their life from hand to mouth or starvation. They live in a very narrow area along with various domestic animals like goats, sheep etc. They are tending of these domestic animals for maintaining their lives because they are dispossess from various jobs and do not get actual wage. They are deprived from all facilities provided by the government. Their living condition is very unhygienic. They have no sanitary latrine and no opportunity to get safe drinking water, proper health facilities. All the women and children bear the sign of malnutrition. They don't know what types of facilities are provided by government cause of their lack of knowledge and also ignorance of the mainstream people. But now they are very conscious and aware about themselves after doing various workshops and meeting about their proper enrollment in voter list and what types of facilities they get after this enrollment. Now they are aware about their various rights and interested to demand their rights.

## 1.12 Recommendations and Conclusion

Although the project was mainly focused on ensuring Munda people in the voter list, Munda community have expressed their concern for future and also provided some strategic directions.

CDP with the support of the project staffs who are from the Munda Community have identified the following recommendations which reflects both the future demand of the Munda community and the future plan of the CDP concerning Munda people:

Recognize Munda as indigenous people at all administrative levels (Upazilla, District, and Division) of the country

Ensure birth registration of the Munda Children

Media should take more responsible role to promote the Munda community.

Take step for protect the language, culture and traditions of the indigenous Munda community

Try to stop the mainstream violence against Munda for acquiring their land

Ensure land rights of the Munda community and distribute khas land to the landless Munda people

Provide allowance & free treatment to the older Munda people

Establish special indigenous school to provide standard education to the Munda children in their own language

Provide scholarship to the Munda students from secondary to higher studies.

Ensure Government reliefs for the Munda community.

Take step to ensure safe drinking water & provide deep tube well.

Provide hygienic sanitation and provide loans without interest to construct making hygienic sanitation.

Provide loan in small interest for alternative livelihood.

Stop wage-related discrimination and provide proper wage to lead a decent life.

Provide various training system especially for the women like handicrafts, livestock etc.

Conduct Survey to determine actual number of the Munda people and identify their situation & concerns

Take initiatives to build Munda organization in village, union, thana and district level

Most of the indigenous Munda people are living with economic, social and political marginalization and they have virtually no opportunity to participate in the national democratic process. As a consequence, they are yet unable to protect themselves against social, political and economic injustices from the mainstream society and also to influence national decisions for reducing discrimination against them. Because of their marginal status, they often lack self-confidence. This envisages that Munda community requires special supports to ensure the full and free participation of indigenous people in all aspects of society as stated in the Vienna Declaration on Human Rights and Programme of Action, adopted at the World Conference on Human Rights and also in the Agenda 21, adopted at the United Nations Conference on Environment and Development (Earth Summit). The project implementation played a pioneer role to enroll the Munda communities in voter list. The project has created a good self-image among the community people (Munda). They are taking collective initiatives for their rights and preventing different social problems. In the long run, enlisted Munda voters will be able to get various facilities.
